

**The enclosed Busking Conditions apply to Salamanca Place, Salamanca Square, Salamanca Lawns, Kennedy's Lane and Woobys Lane during the operation of Salamanca Market and/or occasional Special Sunday Salamanca Markets under the Terms and Conditions of a Busking Licence and in conjunction with the Parks, Recreation and Natural Areas By-Law, By-Law 4 of 1997. Under Section 145 of the Local Government Act 1993.**

## **GENERAL**

A temporary Buskers Licence can be issued by the Market Supervisor on Market day,

A Busking Licence holder may place a receptacle on the ground for the receipt of public donations but shall not ask or in any way solicit or seek a payment in return for a service, eg. hair plaiting, face painting, shoe shine, bubble making, portrait sketching, balloon tying unless approved by the duty Market Supervisor.

All performance times will be limited to a maximum of 20 minutes, with a minimum break of 20 minutes between performance periods, or as determined by the Market Supervisor.

The use of sound amplification or electrically amplified instruments by Busker Licence Holders will be allowed, but this use, including the level or volume of amplification, is at the absolute discretion of the Council's Market Supervisor.

Larger groups of Busker Licence holders must only operate within the designated busking areas detailed on the site plan detailed below, or an area designated by the Council's Market Co-ordinator or the duty Market Supervisor.

Designated busking areas, at the discretion of the duty Market Supervisor, may be used for solo busking performance where the type of performance is expected to attract a large audience, or issues of pedestrian congestion and busker/general public safety are to be considered.

Busking groups of less than three Busker Licence holders, or solo busking performers, may use designated areas, but again this use will be at the discretion of the duty Market Supervisor.

A Busking Licence holder may busk in an area that is not a designated busking area, so long as this performance does not impinge on or interfere with a stallholder's site business or the general operation of the Market as defined by the Market Supervisor;

A Busking Licence may be made inoperative at the discretion of a Council representative at those times when organised displays, activities or events are being staged within the Market environment (including Salamanca Square, Salamanca Lawns, Kennedy's Lane and Woobys Lane ) either by the Council or by another party under a Council permit.

Upon receipt of a complaint that a Busking Licence holder is not observing the conditions detailed in this form, the Manager Customer Services & Parking Operations may cancel the Licence by notice in writing to the Licence holder.

If, in the Council's opinion, it is in the public interest to do so at any time, the Council may cancel all or any Busking Licence or amend the conditions under which they are held.

If, in the Council's opinion, the activity to be conducted by the Busking Licence holder is to be inherently dangerous, the Council will require the Licence holder to indemnify the Council and to produce evidence of public liability insurance for five million dollars (\$5m) for the period of the Busking Licence.

Applications for issue of a new Busking Licence for the next licence period will be received at the Council office from 14 days before the current licence expiry date.

## **PERMITTED ACTIVITIES**

### **A Busking Licence Holder SHALL:-**

At all times when performing, display a current Licence card issued by Council, so that the public can readily view the Licence number and expiry date;

Comply with any lawful direction of a Police officer, duty Market Supervisor or an authorised Council officer;

Acknowledge that in relation to busking activities at Salamanca Market as defined in this Licence, the decision of the duty Market Supervisor shall be final;

At the time of the Licence period or at the direction of the Manager Customer Services & Parking Operations return the Licence card to the Hobart Council Centre, 16 Elizabeth Street Hobart;

Acknowledge rights of other Buskers and limited busking sites at Salamanca Market on days of high Busker visitation at the Market;

Only sell recordings (including but not limited to CDs or cassettes) of their musical repertoire;

Perform within the hours of 8.30am to 3.00pm.

Not obstruct or hinder the passage of pedestrians, vehicles or prevent a stallholder from trading, as determined by the Market Supervisor;

Not create any nuisance or unreasonable noise or perform in a manner that, in the opinion of Tasmania Police, Market Supervisor or authorised Council officer, is offensive to the public;

Not play pre-recorded music when not performing;

Not wear or display any advertising matter, whether or not commercial in nature;

Not perform during Salamanca Market contrary to a direction of the duty Market Supervisor.
